

Renewing Your CRNA Certification

CPC Program: Components

The CPC Program includes four components: Class A credits, Class B credits, Core Modules and the CPC Assessment.

- 60 required per 4-year cycle
- Earn through CE courses or activities
- Must be prior-approved & include assessment
- Examples: Online courses, webinars, workshops

Class A Credits



Class B Credits



- 40 required per 4-year cycle
- Earn through professional activities
- Examples: Teaching, publishing, research
- Prior approval and assessment not required

Core Modules



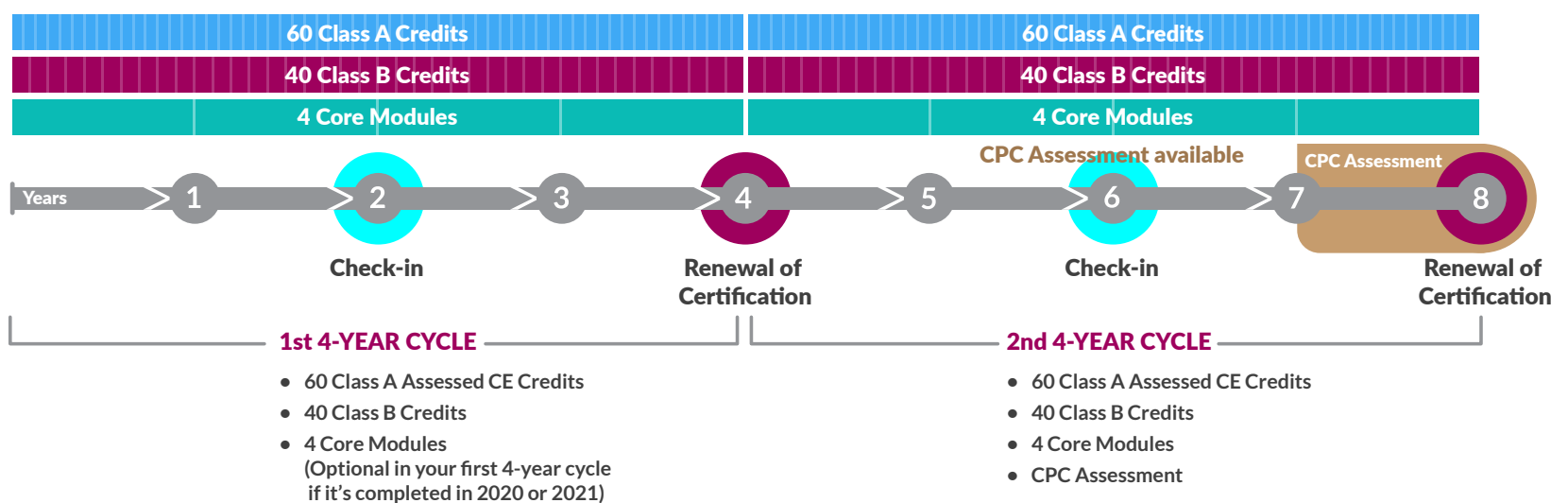
- 4 required per 4-year cycle, one from each of the four core knowledge areas of anesthesia practice:
 - > Airway management
 - > Applied Clinical Pharmacology
 - > Human Physiology and Pathophysiology
 - > Anesthesia Equipment and Technology
- Focused on current literature and evidence-based knowledge
- Core Module credits also count as Class A credits
- The Core Modules are optional in the first 4-year cycle if completing that cycle in 2020 or 2021

CPC Assessment



- Required once every 8 years, available anytime in the second 4-year cycle
- Is not pass/fail and does not impact certification
- Identifies any areas in need of additional study
- A performance standard assessment of the four core knowledge areas of nurse anesthesia practice
